FOOD DISTRIBUTION

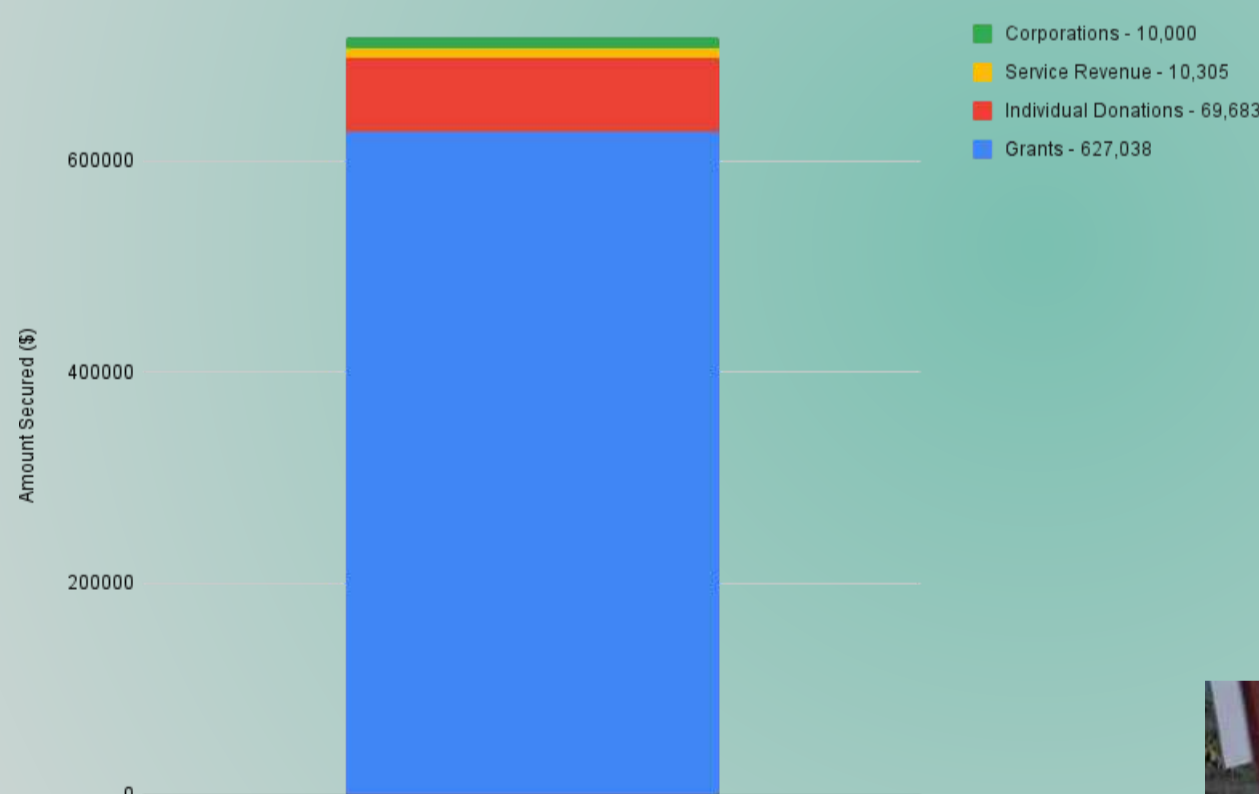
- With partners, distributed fresh food to Roosevelt school district and senior centers
- Supported nutrition of 13,018 individuals
- July 1 - Dec. 2020, distributed 45,387 lbs of fresh produce
- Jan. 1 - June 30, 2021, distributed 25,740 lbs of fresh produce

HEALTH WORKSHOPS

- 184 community health workers (CHWs) have been trained on education, leadership, and health issues
- 2020 - 2021, hosted 1,082 hrs of health education on tobacco cessation and chronic disease control and prevention
- Jan. 1 - June 30, 2021, hosted 20 2-hour trainings for CHWs

ESL AND GED CLASSES

- 2020-2021, continued classes online and developed a summer program which included music, physical activity and personal growth.
- ESL - enrolled 60 participants
- GED - enrolled >40 students

HEALTH START PROG.

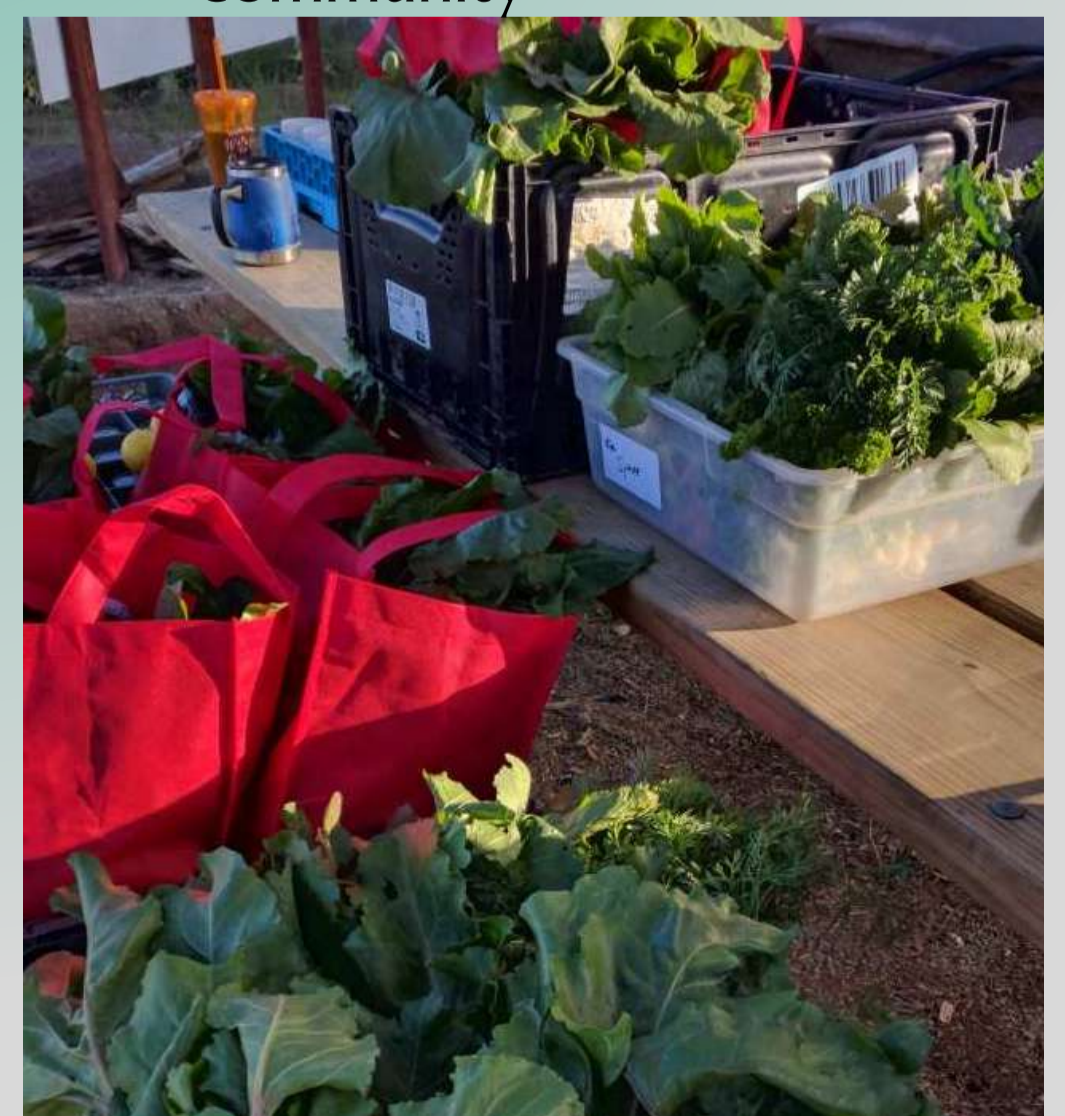
- 2020 - 2021, enrolled 133 individuals in the Health Start Program

- 2020 - 2021, CHWs completed 10,642.5 hrs of volunteer work in the community












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Know our clients

 <p>78% self-identified as females and 20% as males</p>	 <p>Individuals report they are unable to provide the food that their family needs or desires.</p>
 <p>18% are ages between 18 to 35 years, 46% are 36 to 50 years, 24% are between 51 to 64</p>	 <p>61% of households have severe energy insecurity in both summer and winter</p>
 <p>83% self-report Hispanic ethnicity</p>	 <p>67% of the households have severe annual energy burden.</p>
 <p>84% of our clients have an income below 100% federal poverty level</p>
